Scholarship Type A: **Continuing Scholarship for Tuition & Education Support fees**
A1 - Full Scholarship (100% Tuition & Education Fees with Thesis Support)
A2 - Full Scholarship (100% Tuition & Education Fees without Thesis Support)

Type B: **Scholarship for Research/Thesis Support (Max. 25,000 Baht/Semester/Student)**
B1 - Continuing Research/Thesis Support (Until graduate)
B2 - 1- Semester Research/Thesis Support

Candidates' Qualifications:

- Meet qualifications of SIIT graduate programs admission (http://www.siit.tu.ac.th/graduate_introduction_en.htm)
- Strong academic background and recommendations
- Have good health and good conduct
- Must not be a recipient of other scholarships that cover the same type of expenses.

***Note:** Any thesis/research topic can be submitted for consideration; however, in case of similar proposal quality, priority may be given to the projects in the areas of interests of Bangchak Petroleum PCL, for example, low carbon technologies, chemical and environmental engineering, renewable energy, logistics and supply chain management, etc.*


Conditions to Continue the Scholarships (A1 and A2) :

1. Maintaining the cumulative GPA of not less than 3.00 with no "F", "U" or "W" grades
2. Making good progress in his/her master thesis/doctoral dissertation and reporting his/her progress every semester
3. Acknowledge "**Partly financially supported by Bangchak Petroleum PCL, Thailand**" in his/her publication
4. Work as a proctor for at least 4 examination periods during midterm examination and at least 4 examination periods during final examination.
5. Assist other Institute's work, as assigned by the Institute under supervision of the Head of School and/or the academic advisor, for at least 30 hours per semester in the semester that receives the scholarship.
