Good Academic Performance and Good Conduct (GAC)

Applicant's Qualifications:

- 1. Be an SIIT regular undergraduate 2nd 4th year student who has studied at SIIT for at least 2 regular semesters on the date of the application submission
- 2. Has the latest cumulative GPA (CGPA) of at least 3.25
- 3. Must not be simultaneously receiving other SIIT Scholarships, except Financial Needs Scholarships, awards, and educational loans
- 4. Follows the conduct score below:

Cumulative Deducted Score	Disciplinary Action
10 - 69	No consideration of scholarship for 4 semesters
≥ 70	No consideration of scholarship

- Has a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of at least 2.00 when the scholarship is awarded. A student with a CGPA less than 2.25 must attain a semester GPA (SGPA) in the latest semester higher than the student's CGPA
- Has demonstrated financial needs
- Follows the conduct score below:

- Other evidence to support the student's financial status and needs, such as a copy of a loan contract

Outstanding Activity Performance (OAP)

Applicant's Qualifications:

- Be an SIIT regular undergraduate 1st 4th year student who has studied at SIIT for at least one semester on the date of the application submission
- 2. Has a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of at least 2.50 for 1st 3rd year students and 2.00 for 4th year students.
- 3. Has demonstrated a high quality and quantity activity performance:
 - The proposed performance must be performed during the period of being an active SIIT student who has never been considered for this scholarship.
 - The proposed performance should be at least in one of the following categories:

- Academic Potential

- Engineering and Technology

- Sports

- Arts and Culture

- Contribution to Society
