Regulation of Dress Code for SIIT Students
B.E. 2565

It is deemed appropriate to regulate the dress code of SIIT Students, in order to encourage students to respect and follow a polite dress culture, and to guide students to develop proper manners.

By the power of Article 13 of the Thammasat University Regulations on the Management of Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology B. E. 2562, the Director of SIIT hereby repeals the “Announcement of Dress Code for SIIT Students B.E. 2557” issued on September 30, 2014, together with the “Regulation of Uniform and Dress Code for SIIT Students B.E. 2560” issued on April 3, 2017, and issues the Regulation of Dress Code for SIIT Students as follows:

- Section 1** This regulation shall be called the “Regulation of Dress Code for SIIT Students B.E. 2565”
- Section 2** This regulation shall come into force after the date of its official announcement.
- Section 3** In this regulation:
“Students” means all undergraduate and graduate students, including exchange and external students of Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology, Thammasat University.
- Section 4** **Acceptable student clothing for entering SIIT premises and attending classes and on-site examinations:**
Students who enter SIIT premises and attend classes and on-site examinations must dress properly under the regulations of Thammasat University.
- Section 5** **Acceptable student clothing for attending laboratories and workshops:**
Students who attend laboratories and workshops must dress properly under the rules of the school/academic program.
