Regulation of Conduct Score and Disciplinary Actions for SIIT Students
B.E. 2558

Whereas it is deemed appropriate to establish a conduct score system for SIIT students to assist in developing students' ethics and disciplines, by and with the authority according to Section 12 and Section 39 of the Thammasat University Regulations Regarding the Establishment and the Operation of Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT), B.E. 2540, the Director of SIIT hereby repeals the "Regulation of Conduct Score and Disciplinary Actions for SIIT Students B.E. 2556" issued on October 1, 2013, and issues the regulation of conduct score for SIIT students as follows:

Section 1 This regulation shall be called the "Regulation of Conduct Score for SIIT Students, B.E. 2558"

Section 2 This regulation shall come into force after the date of its official announcement.

Section 3 In this regulation:

- "university" means Thammasat University
- "institute" means Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT), Thammasat University
- "student" means Undergraduate and graduate students of SIIT, including external and exchange students.
- "conduct score" means The score defined to manipulate students' development of proper manners. A case related to a quiz or examination shall be considered according to the "Examination Regulations for SIIT Students" instead.

Section 4 The conduct score and disciplinary actions are as follows:

Smoking	Improper Dress		
-	1	0	Action 1: Verbal and written warning 1, and - Permission to attend a class or laboratory, or get service from library is revoked. - No prompt service from SIIT faculty and/or staff member - No consideration for scholarships and awards for 1 academic year (Except for the Good Academic Performance and Good Conduct Scholarships that the applicants must have never been warned to eligible to apply.)
-	2	10	Action 2: Verbal and written warning 2, and - Action 1
1	3	20	Action 3: Verbal and written warning 3, and - Action 2 - No re-entry and re-admission to SIIT
2	4	40	Action 4: Written probation signed by student and guardian - Action 3 - Granting of scholarship and residing of campus-dormitory will be revoked. - No issue of recommendation letter and activity transcript
3	5	70	Action 5: Suspension from study for 1 semester - Action 4 - Suspension from study for one semester (next semester), except for a student studying in the last semester, in which case the student is suspended in the semester of the offence.
4	6	100	Action 6: Postponement of graduation approval for 1 academic year - Action 4 - Postponement of graduation approval for 1 academic year

Section 5

The conduct score will be deducted according to the following guidelines:

- 5.1 In case that a student was found "*improperly dressed*" in a classroom, examination room, laboratory, or SIIT premises at either SIIT Rangsit or Bangkadi campus, the student's conduct score will be deducted as follows:

Offence	Conduct Scores to be Deducted	Cumulative Deducted Scores
1 st Offence	0	0
2 nd Offence	10	10
3 rd Offence	10	20
4 th Offence	20	40
5 th Offence	30	70
6 th Offence	30	100

In addition, either permission to attend a class or laboratory is revoked, or no prompt service from SIIT faculty/staff member, will be imposed on the student at his/her first offence of improper dress.

- 5.2 In the case that a student was found "*smoking in a non-smoking area*" of SIIT premises at either SIIT Rangsit or Bangkadi campus, the student's conduct score will be deducted as follows:

Offence	Conduct Scores to be Deducted	Cumulative Deducted Scores
1 st Offence	20	20
2 nd Offence	20	40
3 rd Offence	30	70
4 th Offence	30	100

- 5.3 The other offences not stated in the above statements, item 5.1 and 5.2, shall be considered on a case-by-case basis by the SIIT Executive Committee, according to the severity of the misconduct.

Section 6

All faculty members and staff shall oversee these regulations by reporting a student's offence to the SIIT Student Affairs and Alumni Relations Division when the offence is found.
