



SIIT Graduate Scholarship Program for Excellent Foreign Students (EFS) Payment Guidelines

• Tuition and Educational Support Fees

In each academic year, tuition and educational support fees in the first and second semesters will be fully waived for only courses in the SIIT curriculum. All the benefits covered in this scholarship are provided for scholarship recipient only. None of the benefits shall be shared to the recipient's spouse and/or children.

• Scholarship Coverage

1. Matriculation of 600 Baht

2. Living allowance (10,000 Baht/month)

2.1 SIIT dormitory fee

The scholarship recipient is **required to stay at the SIIT dormitory for a period of at least 12 months**. During the aforementioned period, the **monthly room rental** fee of 1,900 - 2,100 Baht will be deducted directly from the recipient's living allowance. **The dormitory fee, supported by this EFS scholarship, does not cover the water supply, electricity, telephone bills, and any other utility costs.**

Note: SIIT dormitory is for single occupancy only. The Institute does not provide a dormitory room for scholarship recipient with spouse and/or children.

2.2 Personal living allowance

After the SIIT dormitory fee is deducted, living allowances will be monthly transferred to the recipient's Thai Military Bank PCL (TMB) account, Thammasat-Rangsit Branch.

Note: Due to the time of the registration and scholarship processes at SIIT, you are strongly recommended to bring at least 20,000 Baht of cash to cover the first month expenditures, which may include the items listed below:

3. Travel expenses

Round trip economy international travel expense of not more than 20,000 Baht is provided. The travel route must be the most direct to and from Thailand and the recipient's home country

If travel by an airplane, the scholarship recipient is eligible to reimburse an airplane ticket expense for each trip, at the one-way trip rate subjects to the recipient's home country, as follows:

- Not over 4,000 Baht for Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, India, and Sri Lanka
- Not over 6,000 Baht for Philippines, Indonesia, and Brunei
- Not over 8,000 Baht for Australia
- Not over 9,000 Baht for China, Japan, Korea, Bangladesh, and Nepal
- Not over 10,000 Baht for other countries not listed above

If travel by other means of transportation, the actual expenses will be reimbursed upon the submission of original receipts.

4. Miscellaneous expenses (10,000 Baht, actual expense)

The original receipt must be submitted to the Institute for the scholarship reimbursement: for visa fees, airport taxes, etc.

5. Health and accident insurance

During the period of scholarship, the Institute will provide appropriate health and accident insurance to a scholarship recipient.
