The Scholarships for Students with Outstanding Activity Performance Program aims to encourage students to organize/participate in voluntary campus/community service and leadership activities. With a focus on high quality and quantity of activity performance, we believe that this scholarship program will support our students' capabilities to develop themselves with the desired qualifications of graduates.

2) Amount and Payment:

Excellent	15,000 Baht	 The scholarship will be granted by crediting education and/or tuition fees to the recipient's SIIT account. In case that the amount of scholarship is more than student's registration expense in the applicable semester, the scholarship will be adjusted to the student's outstanding debt. There is an exception for a recipient who has received a full scholarship from another scholarship program. The scholarship will be granted to the student by check or money transfer to his/her bank account.

3) Candidates' Qualifications:

- 3.1 Be SIIT regular undergraduate 1st 4th year students who have at least one semester to be enrolled on the date of application submission.
- 3.2 Have a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of at least 2.50 for 1st 3rd year students and 2.00 for 4th year students.
- 3.3 Have a good conduct: The student must not receive a written warning of misconduct in the prior semester (1 regular semester) and the semester that he/she applies for this scholarship.
- 3.4 Have demonstrated **high quality and quantity** activity performance:
 - The proposed performance must be performed during the period of being an active SIIT student and has never been considered for this scholarship.
 - The proposed performance should be at least in one of the following categories:
 - Academic Potential
- Engineering and Technology
- Arts and Culture
- Society Contribution

4) Application Submission:

Applicants must follow all announcements from the SIIT Student Affairs & Alumni Relations Division regarding the schedule of application deadline, presentation or interview (if any), and result announcement.

Application Deadline: - Scholarships for the **first** semester:

April

- Scholarships for the **second** semester:

October

- Sports

Required documents to be enclosed with the application:

- A copy of the applicant's SIIT Academic Record
- A copy of the applicant's SIIT Activity Transcript
- Evidence, such as certificates and photographs, to verify the student's activity performances

5) Conditions after Receiving a Scholarship:

- 5.1 If it is found that a recipient has falsified any documents or used any false information for the application, the scholarship will be revoked and disciplinary action will be taken.
- 5.2 Recipients shall have an obligation to assist with the Institute's work for not less than 8, 6, or 4 hours for Excellent, Very Good, and Good performance scholarships respectively on the applicable semester or as assigned by the Institute.
